ADDITIONAL CURRICULUM INFORMATION

- *All French Second Language courses in Secondary 5 are taught cross-curricular with Ethics & Religious culture.
- All Social Science/sciences humaines courses in secondary 4 are taught cross-curricular with Ethics & Religious culture or éthique et culture religieuse
- Students in the Chemistry & Physics option courses in Secondary 5 have the option to enroll in a semestered Contemporary World course which would allow them to enroll in a Pre-Calculus option during the second half of the year

Option Courses:

- In Secondary 1 & 2 students will select one Arts option course and remain in the chosen option for both years of cycle 1. The choice of options are: Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, or Music.
- In Secondary 3, students will have 2 option courses chosen from among the Arts options above and other general option. At least one option must be an Arts option.
- In Secondary 4 students will choose 1 Arts option.
- In Secondary 5 students will have the choice of 3 options; at least 1 of the options must be an Arts option. Participation in Secondary 5 Chemistry and Physics option courses require successful completion of Secondary 4 Advanced Science and Secondary 4 Advanced Math. General options vary year to year and may include courses such as Psychology, Film Production and Studies, Computer Applications/Programming and others. *Yoga et bien-être is taught in French.
